Pakistan Public Opinion Survey August 29 – September 13, 2007



Survey Methodology

- In-person, in-home interview
- National representative sample of adult resident of Pakistan.
- n = 4,009
- Conducted between August 29, and September 13, 2007
- Margin of error ±1.58% overall
- Data collected by Socio Economic Development Consultants (SEDCO)



Survey Methodology

- A multi-stage probability sample was used. In the first stage, the sample was stratified into four provinces. In the second stage, the sample was further stratified into districts within each province by rural and urban categories. In the third stage each district was further stratified by Union Councils.
- The sample was distributed at the provincial level, rural and urban, in all four provinces of Pakistan (except for the Federally Administrative Tribal Areas (FATA), Chitral and Kohistan). The sample was then post-weighted to make it proportionate to national representation by province.
- The eligibility criteria is age, which for this survey is 18 years and above.
- The response rate was just over 90 percent.
- The interview teams comprised both of male and females; the female respondents were interviewed by female interviewers and male respondents by male interviewers.
- Kish method was used to select respondents 18 years and older within the randomly selected household. The right hand method was used to select every third household in localities selected through area probability sample.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding error.




When it come to casting your vote in the next election, which of these one issues determine which party you vote for?




Agree or Disagree? Religious extremism is a serious problem in Pakistan









Agree or disagree? The Army should have no role in civilian government








Agree or Disagree? Musharraf should remain as Army Chief of Staff in order to promote stability






Would you support or oppose a constitutional amendment that would allow Musharraf to remain as both President and Army Chief of Staff?

The government should declare an emergency.






Should Benazir Bhutto and Pervez Musharraf make a deal?






Should Bhutto and Musharraf make a deal? PPPP voters (n=1,123) and PML-Q voters (n=641)






What would you prefer Benazir Bhutto and the PPPP do, join APDM or make a deal with Musharraf and PML-Q?






What would you prefer Bhutto and PPPP do, join APDM or make a deal with Musharraf and PML-Q? PPPP voters (n=1,123)






Why do you believe that Bhutto is considering a deal with President Musharraf, to bring democracy to Pakistan or improve her personal situation?






Why do you believe that Bhutto is considering a deal with Musharraf, to bring democracy to Pakistan or improve her personal situation? PPPP voters (n=1,123)





Would you like Benazir Bhutto more or less than you do now if she made a deal with President Musharraf?






Do you think that Pakistan is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?






In the past year, has your personal economic situation improved, worsened or stayed the same?






Thinking about next year do you expect the economic situation in Pakistan to get better, get worse or stay the same?






Agree or Disagree? I feel more secure this year than I did last year






In your opinion how has the government performed on the issues that are important to you?






In your opinion, how has the government performed on the issues most important to you?





Would you say that the ruling coalition has done a good enough job to deserve re-election?






Do you approve or disapprove of the job President Musharraf is doing?










Some people have called for the resignation of President Musharraf. Do you think he should resign?






Who do you believe can best steer the country out of the present crisis, Pervez Musharraf or Benazir Bhutto?






Which one leader do you think can best handle the problems facing Pakistan?






Best Leader by Province






How would you rate each of the following political personalities?






Agree or Disagree? I would like President Musharraf more than I do now if he resigned from the Army






Do you support the re-election of President Musharraf to another term?






Musharraf Re-election by Province






Agree or disagree? President Musharraf should stand for re-election before the current assemblies






Thinking about President Musharraf, would you support his re-election if....?






Are you registered to vote?






If not, why are you not registered to vote? (n=200)






If elections for national assembly were held this weekend how likely is it that you would vote?






If unlikely, why wouldn't you vote? (n=241)






Recently some opposition parties decided to form the All-Parties Democratic Movement. Do you support the APDM?






If the elections were held next week and the following were the parties that formed coalitions, which of these would you vote for?






If Nawaz Sharif returned to Pakistan, would you be more likely or less likely to support PML-N?
