Methodology

The survey was conducted by the Public Opinion and Market research company Baltic Surveys/Gallup on behalf of the International Republican Institute. The field work was carried out by Rating Group Ukraine.

The sample consisted of 2,016 permanent residents of Ukraine older than the age of 18 and eligible to vote (1,200 - representative sample for Ukraine and additional 816 - residents of the Donbas region) and is representative of the general population by age, gender, education and religion.

The sample design was a multi-stage random sample:

<u>Stage one</u>: Ukraine is divided into 27 official administrative regions (25 regions of Ukraine, Kyiv and Sevastopol). All of Ukraine was surveyed.

<u>Stage two</u>: Select settlements - towns and villages. Towns were divided into subtypes according to the size of population (city more than one million, 500,000-999,000, 100,000-499,000, 50,000-99,000, 50,000 and less, village)

There were no more than 14 interviews in each village. This stage, among others, had the following tasks: first, to represent the structure of urban settlements (based on the types of towns), second, to represent each of regions of Ukraine. Towns were selected randomly. The settlement selection step was counted on the basis of the town's population, which had to be determined by interview in particular regions and defined number of urban points of the survey. Villages were selected randomly, according to the abovementioned requirements.


<u>Stage three</u>: At this stage, additional sampling was done in the Donbas region (Donetsk and Luhansk regions) in order to be able to analyze a representative of this region. Additional sample consisted of 816 respondents and was based on the principles described above. Altogether, the survey was conducted in 133 settlements, including 90 urban and 43 rural ones (43 of them - in the Donbas region).


<u>Stage fourth</u>: Respondents were formed on the basis of the quota selection. Population percentage co-relation on the basis of gender and age of citizens of rural and urban settlements of the relevant regions and administrative units of Ukraine were taken into account in the quotas.

Data was collected October 30 – November 11, 2011 through face-to-face interviews with the respondents. The margin of error does not exceed plus or minus 2.2 percent. The response rate was 54.1 percent.





Over the last 12 months, the financial situation of your household has...?










In the next 12 months, do you expect the economic situation in Ukraine will...?







In the next 12 months, do you expect the economic situation in Ukraine will...? (Breakdown by region)



Regardless of your passport, do you consider yourself a...?




Do you think it is acceptable or not if some groups of people use the following methods of protests? How acceptable is each of these forms? (West Ukraine)




Do you think it is acceptable or not if some groups of people use the following methods of protests? How acceptable is each of these forms? (Center/North Ukraine)














Do you approve or disapprove the practice of appointing officials from the Donbas region to serve as heads of local state administrations or in other administration positions in your city/region?




Do you approve or disapprove the practice of appointing officials from Donbas region to serve as heads of local state administrations or in other administration positions in your city/region?




What is your opinion about the idea that heads of state administrations should be elected by the citizens, not appointed by the President?




Would you support the international community freezing the international assets of and suspending visas for Ukrainian officials, including judges, engaged in corrupt practices?






If Ukraine was able to enter only one international economic union, should it be with...?












Please tell me, which three of the following issues are the most important for you personally? (All mentioned issues, West Ukraine)




Please tell me, which three of the following issues are the most important for you personally?

(All mentioned issues, Center/North Ukraine)









Ideally, if you had the opportunity, would you like to move permanently to another country, or would you prefer to continue living in this country?




Ideally, if you had the opportunity, would you like to move permanently to another country, or would you prefer to continue living in this country? (Breakdown by region)




To which country would you like to move?

(Respondents who would like to move to another country, N=264)




What are the reasons why you would like to permanently move abroad? (Respondents who would like to move to another country, N=264)




Do you intend to vote in the parliamentary elections in 2012? (Breakdown by region)


What would make you more likely to vote for a political party?




What would make you more likely to vote for a political party?




Have you heard about the process of developing a new draft parliamentary election law? Do you think this process was open and transparent or not?





Do you think the 2012 parliamentary elections will be...?




Do you think the 2012 parliamentary elections will be...? (Breakdown by region)






Which of these sources do you use for obtaining political information? (West Ukraine)




Which of these sources do you use for obtaining political information? (Center/North Ukraine)




Which of these sources do you use for obtaining political information? (South/East Ukraine)




Which of these sources do you use for obtaining political information? (Donbas)




How many times per week do you access the Internet?



How many times per week do you access the Internet? (Breakdown by region)




Where do you most often regularly access the Internet? (Internet users, N=534)


