

### Southern Region of Iraq Survey of Public Opinion

November 24-30, 2011

## Survey Methodology





- Interviews were conducted November 24-30, 2011.
- Data collection was performed by trained employees of the International Republican Institute (IRI). The sample frame was based on the latest population estimates by the Iraq Central Organization for Statistics and Information Technology and a 2007-2008 United Nations World Food Program survey. Consultative guidance on fieldwork and analysis was provided by Pechter Polls of Princeton, New Jersey.
- Throughout this survey, the southern region refers to the provinces of Basra, Maysan, Muthanna, Dhi-Qar and Qadisiya. Southern region data from previous IRI polling reflects the weighted sample of these five provinces.
- The target population of the southern region is adults 18 years and older. A stratified multistage sample procedure was used for interviewing. Population within provinces was broken down by districts and geography (urban/rural). Quotas were set by district and by geography within each district.
- Sample starting points were chosen within districts based by either going to the center of
  the mahala or to the largest mosque and dropping a pen or pencil on the ground and
  spinning it. The direction the pen/pencil pointed toward was the direction that the
  interviewing started. Every fourth dwelling on the left side of the nearest street was
  sampled until the quota was met. The last birthday method or Kish table method was used
  for actual respondent selection within each household.

- A total of 642 interviews were completed. The margin of error is plus or minus 3.87 percent overall. Quotas were set by province to allow for provincial analysis and all 642 interviews have been weighted proportionally by province and gender.
- After the data was collected, provincial results were weighted in proportion to the Southern Region population. For example, Basra represents 36.5 percent of the registered voters in the southern region; therefore the 234 interviews collected from Basra were weighted to 36.5 percent of all interviews. Similar weighting was applied to each province to ensure that data are consistent with actual registered voter estimates and previous surveys.
- Gender in the survey was 73.9 percent male and 26.1 percent female. Gender was weighted to reflect the estimated numbers in the southern region: 51 percent male and 49 percent female.
- Verification was performed on 10 percent of the sample, either by actual observation or through follow-up interviews.
- Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding error; in all cases where don't know or refuse to answer rates are more than 10 percent, the information is displayed.
- When results are broken down by province, gender or religion, the percentage of the total sample is displayed.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies.









### How would you describe the current economic situation in Iraq: Is it very good, somewhat bad or very bad?



### Over the last year, has your household's financial situation: Gotten much better, gotten somewhat better, gotten somewhat worse, gotten much worse or stayed the same?








#### Would you prefer that the provincial councils or the federal government were stronger?




#### Would you prefer that the provincial councils or the federal government were stronger?




### How important is it you personally that Iraq have a government that is secular or not secular?











#### How would you describe the current economic situation in your province: Is it very good, somewhat good, somewhat bad or very bad?




#### In your opinion, is it important to have a census in your province?




#### In your opinion, how serious do you think the central government is towards integrating the Sons of Iraq (*Al-Sahwa*) into Iraq's government institutions?




#### A proposal has been made to hold provincial council elections this year. Do you want provincial elections to be organized this year?




#### How important do you think it is that elections are held for local councils this year?




#### Regarding tensions between Arabs and Kurds in Ninawa, Diyala and Kirkuk, how likely do you think the situation will turn violent in the next year?




If a referendum were held regarding the status of Kirkuk and the residents of Kirkuk voted to join the Kurdish region, would you respect the results of the referendum?




# If a referendum were held regarding the status of Kirkuk and the residents of Kirkuk voted to become their own region, would you respect the results of the referendum?




#### If a referendum were held regarding the status of Kirkuk and the residents of Kirkuk voted for the status-quo, would you respect the results of the referendum?




## How would you describe the performance of Maysan's Mayor: Is it very good, somewhat bad or very bad?










## In your opinion, how important is it to have investment in your province by the federal government?






## In your opinion, how important is it to have international investment in your province?













Do you think the provincial government of Dhi-Qar provides enough support to the marshlands projects and design to reduce the drying of Iraq's marshes?




## How would you describe the performance of female elected officials in Qadisiya? Is it very good, somewhat good, somewhat bad or very bad?
