Bosnia and Herzegovina: Understanding Perceptions of Violent Extremism and Foreign Influence



Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u> by <u>Ipsos</u> global market research and consulting firm.
- Data was collected between March 29 and April 12, 2018 through in-home, in-person interviews using the CAPI (Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing) method.
- A total of 1,513 interviews were completed with an overall margin of error of +/- 2.5% at the midrange of the 95 percent confidence level for the full sample. A nationally representative sample was based on a multistage stratification proportionate to population sample distribution, with a random selection of households and respondents within each Primary Sampling Unit (PSU). The first level was the region and the second level was the type of settlement.
- Using data from the 2013 census as statistical documentation for sample design, the sample is made up of citizens of BiH, aged 18+.
- Sampling frame: Polling stations territory (approximate size of census units) within strata defined by municipalities and type of settlements (urban and rural).
- Households were selected by a random route technique. Starting from a given address, interviewers selected the third house down the same side of the street (or the next available household for interview) as the starting point of the route. From there, following house numbers in ascending order down the right side of the street, the interviewers selected every third house number for interview. At every crossroad, interviewers turned right and continued to follow this pattern. In the case of apartment buildings, interviewers are allowed to select two apartments in buildings of four stories or fewer and three apartments in buildings with five or more stories (unless the building is in a village, in which case only two apartments are allowed to be selected).
- Respondent selection utilized the Kish grid: a method for randomly selecting household respondents.

Map of BiH Administrative Divisions














Which specific media outlet do you trust the most for your news?




What is your opinion of the role of the United States, Russia, Turkey and Saudi Arabia in BiH?


What is your opinion of the role of United States, Russia, Turkey and Saudi Arabia in BiH?




What is your opinion of the role of United States, Russia, Turkey and Saudi Arabia in BiH?




What is your opinion of the role of Turkey in BiH?




What is your opinion of the role of Russia in BiH?




What is your opinion of the role of United States in BiH?




Why do you support BiH's accession?











Who is the biggest foreign investor in BiH?








Which major Russian investment are you aware of?




Are you aware of any major Turkish investments in BiH?




Which major Turkish investment are you aware of?





Are you aware of any major investments from Saudi Arabia or other Gulf states in BiH?




Which major investment from Saudi Arabia or other Gulf states are you aware of?








What is your religion?



Compared to other people of your religion, do you observe religious practices and rules much more strictly, somewhat more strictly, somewhat less strictly, or much less strictly?






How religious would you say you are?

How would you evaluate the level of influence of religious communities in the country?













How big of a problem is violent extremism in BiH?






Are there groups or individuals in your community that are prone to violent extremism?

How would you rate the level of intensity of interethnic tension in your community?




How would you rate the intensity of inter-ethnic tension in your community?













To what extent do you support or oppose legal consequences, including prison terms, for returning BiH citizens who participated in foreign conflicts?



Do you believe BiH citizens returning from fighting in foreign conflicts represent a security threat?











Would you support or oppose the rehabilitation and reintegration of returnees from foreign conflicts into BiH society?






Who should be responsible for reintegration?

(Respondents who support the rehabilitation and reintegration of returnees from foreign conflicts into BiH society: n=511. First mentions.)




Can you name one or more public personalities in BiH with whom you associate the fight against violent extremism?




Can you name one or more public personalities in BiH who you associate with the fight against violent extremism?

How would you evaluate the work of Dragan Mektic as Minister of Security?





How would you evaluate the Ministry of Security's efforts to raise public awareness of violent extremism?




How would you evaluate the Ministry of Security's efforts to raise public awareness of violent extremism?


Do you believe government agencies are taking sufficient measures to prevent terrorist attack?

How satisfied are you with the current political order in BiH?






Considering how you are treated in interactions with government authorities, which of the following statements is most accurate?


If you have a concern about a government service, department, or employee, how satisfied are you with the options available to you to address those concerns?

What is your view?




