Public Opinion Survey of Residents of Poltava

August 1-3, 2020



Methodology


- The survey was conducted by the Sociological Group "Rating" on behalf of the <u>Center for Insights</u> and <u>Survey Research (CISR)</u> of the <u>International Republican Institute</u>.
- The survey was conducted from August 1-3, 2020 using a CATI method (computer-assisted telephone interviews) based on a random sample of mobile phone and landline numbers.
- The total sample consists of 412 residents of Poltava aged 16 and older. The results have been weighted according to age and gender indicators based on data from the State Statistics Committee of Ukraine as of 01/01/2018.
- Outgoing calls have been made using the numbers of the largest mobile operators in Ukraine: KYIVSTAR, VODAFONE Ukraine and LIFECELL, as well as landline numbers.
- The margin of error at the 95 percent confidence level does not exceed 4.9 percent.
- The response rate was 9 percent.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- The study was funded by the National Endowment for Democracy.





"There is enough for everyday expenses, but it is already difficult to buy clothes" (Subsistence income); 3. "Basically enough, but not enough for buy expensive items" (Adequate Income); 4. "Almost everything is enough, but buying an apartment, a house is not available" (Secure Income); and 5. "We deny ourselves practically nothing" (Secure Income).




In general, would you say that things ... are heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?




In general, would you say that Ukraine is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?




Do you think that things in your city are going in the right direction or in the wrong direction?






How likely or unlikely are you to vote in the local elections scheduled for October 2020?




How likely or unlikely are you to vote in the local elections scheduled for October 2020?




What is the primary reason you are unlikely to vote in the October local elections?

(Among those who are unlikely to vote in the elections (n=63), Spontaneous response)




If local elections were held this coming Sunday, for which party, if any, would you vote?

(All respondents Spontaneous response)




If local elections were held this coming Sunday, for which party, if any, would you vote?

(Among those who named a party and intend to vote (n=191), Spontaneous response)




Did you vote in the last parliamentary elections in Ukraine in 2019?






Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of ...




Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the President of Ukraine Volodymyr Zelenskyy?



Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the Cabinet of Ministers under Denys Shmyhal?




Do you approve or disapprove of the activities of the Parliament of Ukraine?





In general, do you approve or disapprove of the work of your city council?










In the past two years, have you had to interact with your city's government offices?




How satisfied were you by the service received from the local authorities?

(Among those who have interacted with city government offices in the past two years (n=150))







Do you feel safe walking home alone in your neighborhood in the evening?




Do you feel safe walking home alone in your neighborhood in the evening?







Do you feel that men and women in your city have equal rights and opportunities?








If there are two candidates running for mayor in your city and they have the same qualifications aside from the fact that one is a man and one is a woman, which candidate are you more likely to support?




If there are two candidates running for mayor in your city and they have the same qualifications aside from the fact that one is a man and one is a woman, which candidate are you more likely to support?


