### Public Opinion Survey: Residents of Armenia

August 2020



#### Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's (IRI) Center for Insights in Survey Research by Breavis (represented by IPSC LLC).
- Data was collected throughout Armenia between August 15 and August 25, 2020, through phone interviews, with respondents selected by the random digit dialing (RDD) probability sampling of mobile phone numbers.
- The sample consisted of 1,515 permanent residents of Armenia aged 18 or older. It is representative of the population with access to a mobile phone, which excludes approximately 1.2% of adults.
- Sampling frame: Statistical Committee of the Republic of Armenia.
   Weighting: Data weighted for 11 regional groups, age, gender and community type.
- The margin of error does not exceed plus or minus 2.5 points for the full sample.
- The response rate was 23 percent. This response rate is substantially lower than IRI's most recent survey in Armenia, which was held during the State of Emergency and may have temporarily boosted response rates. Additional vetting of the sample did not reveal any particular bias related to the lower response rate.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.
- The survey was funded by the <u>U.S. Agency for International Development.</u>









### How much, if anything, would you say you know about human rights in general?




### In your opinion, how often have your rights been violated in Armenia in general...?




### In your opinion, how often have your rights been violated in Armenia in general before April 2018?




### In your opinion, how often have your rights been violated in Armenia in general <u>after April 2018</u>?




# In your opinion, how often have your rights been violated in Armenia in general <u>during the State of Emergency established to prevent the spread of coronavirus?</u>




### In what period were these rights and freedoms the most violated in Armenia?




### In what period were these rights and freedoms violated most in Armenia? (when specific periods are indicated)














Do you think the Armenian government is doing a good job or a bad job at protecting human rights, or is the government making no difference?












## In the last year, have you noticed any cases of insulting, hostile or threatening behavior toward a person based on the following criteria?












### How frequently are the elderly the target of hate speech in Armenia?




### How frequently are <u>religious minorities</u> the target of hate speech in Armenia?




### How frequently are <u>people with different or oppositional political</u> <u>views</u> the target of hate speech in Armenia?










### Do you think these groups need special protection from hate speech?




## Do you think these groups need special protection from hate speech? (comparison with the perception of being targeted often)







#### How often do you use online social networks?




#### How often do you notice hate speech in social networks? (among social network users)




### How often do you notice hate speech towards yourself in social networks?

(Among those who noticed hate speech in social networks, n=1,087)




### How did you react to hate speech against you on online social networks?

(Among respondents who experienced hate speech, n=90)




# How likely are you to post your opinions online after you experience hate speech? (Those who use online social networks, n=1,238)









#### Age, Gender, Community Type, Province Distribution




#### What is the highest level of education you have attained?












