### Community-level Survey on Perceptions of Rohingya Refugees and Social Cohesion in Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh

### Detailed Methodology


- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for</u> <u>Insights in Survey Research (CISR)</u> by <u>Innovative Research & Consultancy (IRC)</u>.
- Data was collected between December 4<sup>th</sup> and December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, through computerassisted personal interviewing (CAPI) administered face-to-face interviews at respondents' homes.
- The sample consisted of n=1,050 adult (aged 18+) residents of Nhilla Union and Whykong Union, located in Teknaf Upazila,<sup>\*</sup> Cox's Bazaar, Bangladesh.
- A multi-stage probability sampling method was used to design a sample representative of Nhilla and Whykong unions according to data from the 2011 Census.
  - Within Nhilla and Whykong unions, villages were selected as the primary sampling units via probability proportionate to size (PPS). Across selected villages, interviews were distributed proportionally according to population size and proximity to Camp 21 and Camp 26.
  - Within primary sampling units, households were selected via a *random route* procedure.
  - Respondents were selected under a 50/50 gender quota and a *next birthday* protocol.
- The response rate for the survey was 88%. The margin of error for the midrange of the full sample is ±3.0-points at the 95% confidence level.
- No post-stratification weighting was applied to the survey data.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100% due to rounding.




# How would you rate the availability of these basic goods and services for you and your household over the last 12 months?




## How would you rate the availability of jobs or any employment over the last 12 months?






#### What is your key source of information for each of the following issues? Local Politics






# How satisfied are you with the government provision of services in your upazila during the last 12 months?



## From which of these nongovernment actors do you receive services such as security, education or infrastructure?






#### How frequently do you interact with the Rohingya refugees, if at all?




### How would you describe interactions with the Rohingya?










## Please rate the current *national government*'s performance on addressing the Rohingya refugee issue



### How has your life changed since the arrival of the Rohingya?




## If you, your family member, or friend was a victim of violence, who would you first call to report it?




















### What do you consider to be the biggest threat you face in your upazila?




### And what/whom do you feel most threatened by when you leave your home?








# Would you say that the level of violence in this upazila has improved, worsened or stayed the same in the past year?









## Speaking of the key actors who bring security or insecurity, how often do you see them in your upazila?




# When there is insecurity and violence in your upazila, who, in your view, is the primary target of those attacks?



## Confidence in Key Institutions Providing Security




### In whom do you have the most confidence to resolve issues in your upazila?



# Which of these individuals or groups do you believe are legitimate, meaning that they are able to deliver just and proper outcomes through their role or authority in a community?






### Where were you asked for a bribe most recently?


### How often were you asked to pay a bribe in the last 12 months?
