Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the US Agency for International Development and the International Republican Institute's Center for Insights in Survey Research by a research firm in Southeast Asia under the supervision of Redstone Scientific.
- Data was collected between January 17 and February 16, 2024, through Computer-Assisted Telephone Interviewing (CATI).
- The sample consists of n=2,402 adults 18 years of age and older across all states and regions of Myanmar.
- Data collection was conducted through two sampling methodologies, split approximately in half between Random Digit Dialing (RDD) and the random selection of respondents from a pre-existing proprietary panel of over 250,000 households. The panel was recruited from previous face-to-face surveys and separate recruitments. Sample quotas were implemented for urbanicity, state/region, age, and gender based on the 2014 census.
- The panel sample was sorted by state/region and urbanicity. The total sample frame for each location was divided by the sample size required and every nth phone number was selected for an interview attempt.
- For the RDD sample, a mobile phone sample was randomly generated using the prefixes allocated to local mobile operators (MPT, Ooredoo, MyTel, and Telenor).
- For both the panel and RDD methodologies respondents answering the phone were selected using the Last Birthday Method.
- The achieved sample was weighted for state/region, urbanicity, gender, age, and education based on the 2014 census.
- The overall response rate was 19 percent.
- The margin of error is plus or minus 2 percentage points at the midrange with a confidence level of 95%.
- CATI surveys are dependent upon cell phone penetration and exclude non-mobile users from the sample frame. There is also an impact on the non-response rate, depending upon respondent willingness to answer and speak on a mobile.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.




In general, would you say that our country is heading in the right direction or the wrong direction?






Why do you think the country is heading in the right direction?








Why do you think the country is heading in the wrong direction?

Among those who declared wrong direction; n=1,546; spontaneous response; multiple responses allowed






























How would you rate the availability of these basic services for you and your household over the last 12 months?






In the past year, have you received services such as security, education or healthcare?

Among those who received services, n=812; multiple responses accepted













How positively or negatively do you view the change of government that occurred on the 1st of February 2021?





