Detailed Methodology

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u> by <u>Solutions Consultant Pvt. Ltd.</u>
- Data was collected between June 4-23, 2024, through computer-assisted telephone interviewing (CATI), administered on respondents' mobile phones.
- The sample consisted of n=2,400 residents of Nepal with mobile phones, aged 18 and older.
- A random sample was drawn using an RDD (random digit dialing) methodology to generate mobile phone numbers. Numbers were stratified proportionally across Nepal's primary mobile phone carriers (Nepal Telecom and Ncell Axiata LTD) according to their market share. This approach covers approximately 95% of the target population. No socio-demographic quotas were applied during respondent selection, and up to three attempts were made to contact respondents.
- The response rate for the survey was 24%, and the margin of error for the midrange of the full sample does not exceed ± 2.0 -points at the 95% confidence level.
- Interviews were conducted in Nepali (97%) and Maithali (3%).
- The achieved sample was weighted by age, gender, provinces, urbanicity, and educational attainment according to data from the National Statistics Office's *National Population and Housing Census 2021*.
- Cited bases are weighted. Charts and graphs may not add up to 100% due to rounding.




In general, would you say that our country is heading in the right direction or the wrong direction?




In general, why do you think that things are heading in the right direction?

(Among those who believe Nepal is heading in the right direction, n=750; spontaneous response)




In general, why do you think that things are heading in the wrong direction?

(Among those who believe Nepal is heading in the wrong direction, n=1,577; spontaneous response)




What is the most important problem facing our country today?

(Spontaneous response)




What is the most important problem facing our country today?




Over the last 12 months, how has the economic situation of your household changed?




In the coming 12 months, how do you expect the economic situation of your household to change?




How would you rate the current state of Nepal's democracy? Would you say it is good or bad? And would you say that it is very or somewhat good/bad?






Which of the following statements best applies to you?



Thinking now about the following institutions, would you say you approve or disapprove of the job they are doing? Would that be strongly or somewhat approve/disapprove?









Are you registered to vote?



How likely or unlikely are you to vote in general elections scheduled for 2027?




How likely or unlikely are you to vote in general elections scheduled for 2027?




Why are you unlikely to vote in the 2027 general elections?




Do you feel that elections are generally free and fair or not?




Do you agree or disagree that political parties are doing enough to address the needs of voters like you?




Would you like to see new political parties in future elections or are you satisfied with the current choices?

If there are two candidates running for office and they have the same qualifications aside from the fact that one is a man and one is a woman, which candidate are you more likely to support?









Would you say you agree or disagree with the following statement: Nepal's provincial and local governments have autonomy and power to make decisions?








Which of the following news and political television programs do you watch to get election information?




If yes, how often do you use Facebook?

(Among those who use Facebook, n=1,749)





Do you have access to the Internet, either on a phone or a computer?




How often do you use the internet?




